Part A

Inpatient Hospital

Deductible:	Per Benefit Period	\$1,100
Coinsurance:	Days 61-90	\$275/day
	Lifetime Reserve Days (60)	\$550/day

Skilled Nursing Facility

Coinsurance:	Days 21-100:	\$137.50/day
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Monthly Premium:

40 quarters of Social Security work credit -----	Free
30-39 quarters of Social Security work credit -----	\$254

Part B

Deductible:	Per Calendar Year	\$155
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Premium:	*\$96.50 per month or \$110.50
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***Who pays \$96.50 Part B premium in 2010?** Beneficiaries who had Social Security Administration (SSA) withhold their Part B premium in 2009 and have incomes of \$85,000 or less (or \$170,000 or less for joint filers) will not have an increase in their Part B premium in 2010.

***Who pays \$110.50 Part B premium in 2010?** New Part B Medicare enrollees will pay \$110.50 because they did not have the premium withheld from their Social Security check in the previous year and beneficiaries who do not currently have their Part B premium withheld from their Social Security check will pay \$110.50. Individuals whose modified adjusted gross income is greater than \$85,000 (single) or \$170,000 (married couple) pay \$110.50 plus an additional amount.
